Since the last letter, Village elections were held with the following results:

Rosemary Bourne – Mayor, 3<sup>rd</sup> term  
Richard MacDougall – Trustee, 1<sup>st</sup> term  
George Sheehan – Trustee, 4<sup>th</sup> term

The next election will be on June 15, 2010 for two trustee positions. We have a new Building Inspector, Richard Barbieri. His predecessor, Joe Richardson, wished to reduce his work week hours and accepted a position in another Village. We wish him well and thank him for his service to Oyster Bay Cove.

**Police Department:**

Led by Trustee/Police Commissioner George Sheehan and Deputy Police Commissioner Seth Lublin, contract negotiations between the Village and the PBA have been ongoing for several months. A final contract is expected to be reviewed at the next Board of Trustee's meeting. We thank George and Seth for their hard work in conducting these negotiations.

**Nassau County Police Department Radio Site:**

The NCPD recently was granted a license to place 3 antennas and 3 dishes on top of the water tower on Berry Hill Road next to the Tiffany Preserve. The site is in the last five to complete a public safety grade system that replaces a radio system installed in 1982. It will allow seamless communications with villages, towns, and county agencies. The process with the Village has just begun. You will be notified about any hearings.

**Tree Removal Permits:**

To facilitate the permitting process, the Board of Trustees adopted a policy granting the Tree Inspector some discretion in issuing live tree removal permits within the parameters of existing Village law. Hopefully, the policy will address resident concerns and the process will be more user friendly.

**Oyster Bay Triathlon Race:**

Unauthorized road closings in the Village marred this year's race. The organizers were notified in a letter from the Village that, under the terms of their permit, such closings were not permissible. They have made changes to next year's plans to avoid such problems.
